

AUTHOR GUIDELINES

1. Eligibility for Submission:

- The journal welcomes **researchers, academicians, legal professionals, judges, students and others interested** in the field to submit manuscripts.
- Co-authorship is **permitted up to two authors** per manuscript.

2. Submission Process:

- All manuscripts must be submitted via **email to [editorijslr@gmail.com]** with the **subject line: “Submission – [Type of Manuscript] – [Author Name]”**.
- A **separate cover page** must be attached, containing:
 - Title of the manuscript
 - Name(s) of the author(s)
 - Affiliation(s) & designation(s)
 - Contact details (email & phone number)
- The **main document should not contain any author-identifying details** to maintain the double-blind peer review process.

3. Review Process:

- All submissions undergo a **double-blind peer review** by experts in the field.
- Authors may be asked to make revisions based on reviewer feedback.

4. Copyright & Licensing:

- By submitting, authors **grant the journal an exclusive right to publish** and distribute the paper.
- Authors retain the right to republish the work **with prior permission from the journal** and proper citation.
- The journal follows an **Open Access Policy**, ensuring wider reach and accessibility.

5. Ethical Considerations:

- Submissions should be **original and unpublished**.
- Manuscripts **under review or published elsewhere will not be considered**.
- Authors must **disclose any conflict of interest** related to their research.

6. Processing Fees:

- There is a **processing fee of ₹1,000/- for single-authored manuscripts and ₹1,500/- for co-authored manuscripts**, payable only upon acceptance of the manuscript.

- The acceptance of manuscript will be intimated as soon as the peer review process is completed.
- Authors will receive an **e-certificate of publication**.
